

The reasons behind this Pack

The "Charlie's Aces" Pack is an update of MK2's « Aces of North Vietnam » campaign, with additional mods from the community. This campaign only deals with the combats of VPAF above North Vietnam.

I decided about one year ago to burn a CD with all the mods I downloaded from Check-Six, Column5 and CombatAce. Since my main install of WoV is dedicated to MK2's AOVN campaign, I wanted to compile the related mods into an all-inclusive pack that I could easily install.

After all the fun I've had with the mods from the community, it's now been time to share my modest contribution.

I want to make it clear: beside the Vietnamese speech pack done on purpose for the pack, all the mods can be found on the aforementioned sites. I've just put the mods I tought relevant together. I've chosen planes that some might find pointless, while some major SEA era aircraft could be lacking according to others. Well, it's much of a personal choice. Nevertheless, I hope that the pack is comprehensive enough, and that little must be done to tweak it into your own dream Vietnam install.

Content

The Pack is much too big to be zipped into one single archive (817 Mo unzipped). So I cut it into 5 blocks:

- Bloc n°1 Campagnes (21.9 Mo zipped): Aces Of North Vietnam menus and updated campaigns
- Bloc n°2 Dialogues Vietnamien (45.7 Mo zipped): Vietnamese speech pack with two speechtext.str files for both French and English subtitles (with Vietnamese squadron names)
- Bloc n°3 Environnement (59.9 Mo zipped): Effects, skymods, SEAterrain and aircraft sounds
- Bloc Objets 1 et 2 (resp. 62.0 and 69.8 Mo zipped): Aircraft, vehicles and weapons. Too big to fit into one downloadable zip. MiGs are restricted to Sweep and Interception missions, what is historically accurate.

Important:

The 5 blocks are meant to be used together. But you can use Block n°3 for other installs as well.

CAUTION:

Mission loading might be longer when using the modded speechtext.str files.

Required Configuration

The « Charlie's Aces » Pack is supposed to be installed on a dedicated install of Wings over Vietnam.

The install sequence falls into what follows:

- 0) Download the 5 blocks
- a) Install Wings over Vietnam from Third Wire CD-ROM
- b) Install the service pack WOV_SP4 available at Thirdwire website (www.thirdwire.com)
- c) Install the update WOV_p083006 at Thirdwire website
- d) Update DirectX up to 9.0c level
- e) Install « Charlie's Aces » Pack as follows


The Pack unzipped size is 820 Mo. It was tested with Windows XP Pro SP2.

"Charlie's Aces" Pack Installation

1) Unzip the files

- Once you have created a clean, fully patched install of WoV, unzip each block into your **main folder** of the game (the one with the WOV.exe file). Answer "Yes to all" when prompted to overwrite



- If you want to get the French subtitle, just paste the Speechtext.str file from the ...\Speech\Speechtext FR folder into the ...\Speech folder
- If you want to get the English subtitle, just paste the Speechtext.str file form the ...\Speech\Speechtext ENG folder into the ...\Speech folder

2) Red Star Shortcut Icon

- Right click on your "Charlie's Aces" shortcut
- Click on "Properties", "Change icon", "Browse"
- Click on the VPAF.ico file in your dedicated install
- Validate by clicking on "Open", "OK", "Confirm" (the button on the right, don't know its name in English), "OK"

3) Update weaponsdata

- Open the Objects\Weapons\ folder
- Double click on WeaponEditor.exe
- If a window opens then disappears, right click on WeaponEditor.exe, "Properties", "Compatibility", fill in the "Run this program compatibility mode for", choose "Windows 98", validate with "Confirm" (well the button on the right) and "OK"
- Click on "Open", choose the "Weapondata.ini » file and "Open", the weaponlist loads
- Click on "Merge", choose the "AddtoWeapondata.ini" file, new weapons appear at the bottom of the list
- Click on "Save", then "Close"
